

INDIVIDUAL AND PERSONAL.

We employ an interdisciplinary team to support the development of the children entrusted to our care.

The children in our care, with their specific needs, interests, potential, strengths and weaknesses, are the focus of our day-to-day work.

We offer stimulation for development and support for skills and capabilities, as well as strengthening of self-awareness, through playing together and many activities.

Our child-friendly rooms have a spacious and bright design. Our facility has a large outdoor area which encourages children to gain their first experiences of nature.



ALWAYS SOMETHING TO DO.

In addition to space to play freely, in which children can try things out for themselves and develop, they gain their first experiences of playing together and interacting with others here.

During the course of the regular daily routine, your children also experience sophisticated support options and similar. In the field of language development, preparation for school, sports and much more; We support children with handicaps when it comes to language and movement. This support is provided in individual therapy from outpatient practices, among other things.
